Public notice is hereby given that the City of Kirkland has issued the above mentioned Invitation for Bids (IFB). The work to be performed under the Kirkland ITS Implementation Phase 2 project consists of traffic signal cabinet improvements and deployment of intelligent transportation systems (ITS) technology such as closed circuit television (CCTV) cameras, vehicle detection equipment and Accessible Pedestrian Signal (APS) system for improved operations of signalized corridors. The project will also include the installation of fiber optic communications and networking equipment to connect field equipment with the City's Traffic Management Center. The scope will also include the implementation of project temporary traffic control plans to construct the proposed project improvements. The geographic region for the project includes intersections on major arterial roadways within the Totem Lake Urban Center.
