

**Kirkland Transportation Commission  
Meeting Notes

**Call to Order**

Chair Neir called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Members Present: Mike Snow, Kurt Ahrensfeld, John Perlic, Carl Wilson, Tom Pendergrass; Kirkland Staff Present: Kathy Brown, David Godfrey, Thang Nguyen, Rob Jammerman Public Works Department;, Jon Regala, Planning and Building Department.

**Approval of Meeting Notes**

The October 28 meeting notes were unanimously approved.

**Items from the Audience**

David Malcolm asked questions about how bicycle facilities would be handled in the Totem Lake Mall redevelopment project.

**Totem Lake Mall Update**

In a follow up to questions raised at the last Transportation Commission meeting Staff presented plans for redevelopment of the Totem Lake Mall sites. In particular, more materials were shown that described how bicycles and pedestrians would be accommodated in the new project. The Commission was satisfied that their questions had been answered.

**Sound Transit 3**

Staff presented information on ST 3 to the Commission including the notion of funding to accommodate light rail on the CKC but with flexibility to choose a mode on the CKC after an ST 3 vote. The Commission supported the idea of HCT on the CKC with less emphasis on BRT on I-405 and supported the concept that any project on I-405 would require access at NE 85<sup>th</sup> Street. The Commission discussed the pros and cons of BRT vs. LRT on the CKC.

**Metro Long Range Plan**

Staff gave a brief overview of the Metro Long Range Plan, including the network proposed by Metro and the City's comments.

**Work Plan**

It was moved by Pedergrass and seconded by Perlic to approve the proposed Work Plan. The motion carried 6-0.

**Elections**

Using paper ballots, Tom Neir was unanimously elected chair and Jon Perlic was unanimously elected vice chair.

**Updates from Commissioners/Staff**

Staff reminded Commissioners of up coming meetings. There were no reports from Commissioners.
