




Kirkland 2035 Comprehensive Plan Update

Plan to attend the second meeting to discuss Neighborhood Plans for Annexation Areas

If you've reached this page and live in the ***Finn Hill, North and South Juanita, or Kingsgate Neighborhood*** you were annexed into the City in June 2011. Your neighborhood currently does not have a Neighborhood Plan Section within the Kirkland Comprehensive Plan. The existing zoning for your neighborhood are a carryover from King County.

The City is in the process of updating the Comprehensive Plan to look at the future growth 20 years in the future including a community outreach process to obtain input on neighborhood plans.

Now is your chance to become engaged in the process to begin to develop a neighborhood plan for your area.
