

## **Kirkland Cultural Council Meeting Minutes: March 21, 2007**

### **Uncorked:**

However, great strides in communication were made in that they do support the event, and possibilities were discussed as to how they could participate next year. Given the short time schedule, this has to be a building year for this event.
- KAST artists will be doing the “fresh air” art and the Arts Center will be assisting with studio artists.
- KDA met with KCC and agreed to have their booths juried, which is a great victory. They agreed to have 2 jurors from KCC, which Sheila will clarify is still the case.

### **Art in Private Development:**
