



Cross Kirkland Corridor – Adoption FAQ's

When I sign the Agreement, what are my responsibilities as the group leader?

Please take a minute to read the Agreement. In general, please:

- ✓ Keep a copy of the Agreement at the cleanup site.
- ✓ Require all participants sign a consent/hold harmless form prior to participating.
- ✓ Safely have your group pick up litter and trim vegetation on the trail section you adopted at a minimum of twice per year.
- ✓ Return unused bags and the safety vests to the City within one week following cleanup.
- ✓ DO NOT touch anything that might be hazardous or cause injury.
- ✓ DO report hazards to the City of Kirkland Public Works Department or the Police Department.

What are the City's responsibilities under the Agreement?

Please take a minute to read the Agreement. In general, the City will:

- ✓ Furnish and install a permanent sign with the adoptee's name at the adopted section.
- ✓ Provide trash bags and safety vests.
- ✓ Remove the filled trash bags when requested.
- ✓ Assist the volunteers in cleaning up litter under unusual circumstances, such as when large, heavy, or hazardous items are found.

What are the cleanup responsibilities?

The City requests that cleanup occur at a minimum of two times a year. Cleanup duties are:

- ✓ Picking up garbage
- ✓ Trimming vegetation off of trail
- ✓ Reporting hazards to the Public Works Department at (425) 587-3900

Where and when can supplies be picked up?

The City has garbage bags and safety vests available at the Maintenance Center, 915 8th Street, Monday-Friday, 6:30-3:30pm. Please return the vests and unused bags to the Maintenance Center.

What do we do with the filled garbage bags?

After cleanup is completed, the filled garbage bags can be hauled away by the adoptee or the City is available to do this if it is requested at (425) 587-3900 or PWservicerequest@kirklandwa.gov.

Do we "register" our clean-up date with the City?

No, it is not necessary to notify the City or register otherwise when a cleanup is planned or completed.
