


Find out about permit activity in your neighborhood

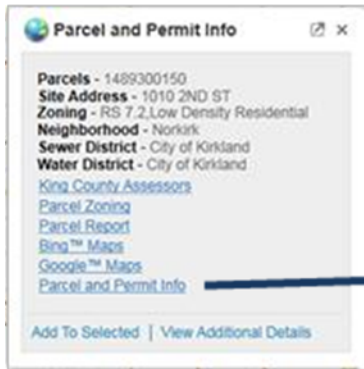

BY PARCEL:

To view all permit information on a property, zoom into the property first and do the following:

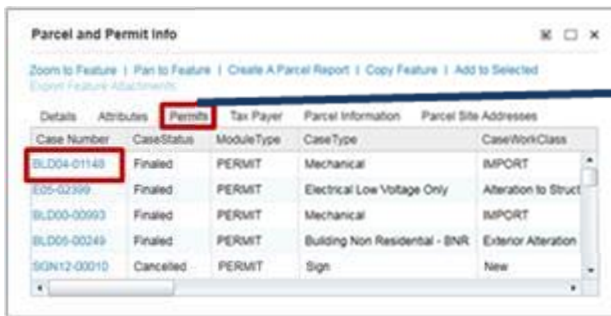


STEPS:

1. Zoom into parcels

2. Left-click parcel and an info box will display

3. Click on "Parcel and Permit Info" and a new window will appear listing permits available from MBP.



4. Click on the Case Number, it will open permit details from MBP. *Please note: there are multiple tabs on this window. You can navigate around different tabs and browser remembers the last tab you have visited.*

BY NEIGHBORHOOD/AREA:

To view permit activities around a neighborhood, do the following:



Steps:

1. Checked the Development Permits Checkbox

2. Click on the +/- sign to expand or collapse the group layers

3. Check or uncheck the layer to display the type of permits

4. Click the legend arrow to see the map legend.

Note: Dots on the map indicate permitting activities.
