



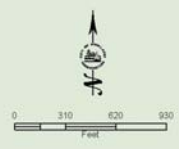
Market Neighborhood 2008 Voting Results

Project #	Votes	Project Description	Estimate
MK—1	198	Heritage Park —Select and install children’s playground in compliance with Heritage Park Master Plan. Design to be determined by the neighborhood and the Park Department. ✓ Funded	\$25,000
Total funds for projects approved			\$25,000
MK—11	153	6th Street West —Create a continuous walkway along the school bus route on south side of 6th St W between Waverly Way and Market St. This takes advantage of the sections of existing sidewalk and uses paint lines on existing shoulder paving where possible. The project is contingent upon the involvement of the residents along both sides of 6th St W in the design and layout because some could lose on-street parking.	\$24,200
MK—5	123	Waverly Way —Add low level lighting along walkway on the west side of Waverly Way to create a walking connect between Heritage and Waverly Park.	\$25,000
MK—2	114	Heritage Park —Construction of an approximately 1,000 square foot half-court basketball court with glass backboard at Heritage Park, near the new tennis courts. Design to be determined by the neighborhood and the Park Department. Project contingent upon fund raising from the neighborhood association to fulfill additional budget requirements as needed	\$25,000
MK—8	114	Waverly Beach —Install a shower to the outside of the beach house at Waverly Park for showers after swimming (similar to Houghton Beach park).	\$17,000
MK—3	80	Heritage Park —Install drinking fountain to be located in close proximity to Heritage Hall because of existing utility facilities. Design could include a ground level dog fountain. (An alternative would be to wait until a future phase of park development occurs, at which time a new restroom will be constructed and a drinking fountain can be included much more economically.)	\$7,000
MK—6	67	Waverly Way —Add a cross walk for crossing Waverly Way at 2nd St W. Project will require a new street light at the crosswalk which will cost \$5,000. There is no charge to the Neighborhood Connection Program for painting the crosswalk markings on the road.	\$5,000
MK—9	53	Avenue West —Install a traffic circle at 10th Ave W and 3 rd St (or 10 th Ave W and 4 th St). The following criteria would need to be met: (a) review and approval by the Kirkland Fire Department; (b) support by 70% of the households within one block of the intersection; (c) approval of the abutting residents; and (d) a volunteer to maintain the landscaping. The low volume of cars at this location makes stop signs ineffective for traffic calming.	\$6,500
MK—7	49	Waverly Way —Install curb bump outs on Waverly as a test for slowing traffic and enhancing pedestrian crossing. Project is contingent on neighborhood working with Public Works to find a feasible location.	\$10,000
MK—10	33	11th Avenue West —Install a traffic circle at 11 th Ave W and 5th St W. The following criteria would need to be met: (a) review and approval by the Kirkland Fire Department; (b) support by 70% of the households within one block of the intersection; (c) approval of the abutting residents; and (d) a volunteer to maintain the landscaping. The low volume of cars at this location makes stop signs ineffective for traffic calming.	\$6,500
