**Subject:** REPORT ON PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES FOR COUNCIL MEETING OF FEBRUARY 17, 2015.

This report is provided to apprise the Council of recent and upcoming procurement activities where the cost is estimated or known to be in excess of \$50,000. The "Process" column on the table indicates the process being used to determine the award of the contract.

The City's major procurement activities initiated since the last report, dated January 22, 2015, are as follows:

	Project	Process	Estimate/Price	Status
1.	Camera Trucks (2) for the Surface & Wastewater Division	Cooperative Purchase	\$485,000 - \$495,000	Order being prepared for purchase from Owen Equipment of Portland, OR using the contract awarded by the National Joint Purchasing Alliance (NJPA).
2.	Purchase a portion of salvaged superstructure from M/V Kalakala	Competitive Process Waived	\$40,953*	City Manager waived competitive process as sole source due to special market conditions.

**Subject:** REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING – Purchase of items salvaged from M/V Kalakala

#### RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the competitive process be waived for the purchase of items salvaged from the M/V Kalakala at a cost of \$40,953. The items purchased include:

1) Wheel room (excluding the front section made of copper)	\$ 15,000.00
3) Two large doors – where cars entered	\$ 3,000.00
4) Valve wheels (4) \$100 each	\$ 400.00
5) Hand railings \$300 per linear foot (10 feet)	\$ 3,000.00
6) Top silver section of the front of the boat with approximately 6 port holes	\$ 16,000.00
Subtotal	\$ 37,400.00
Sales tax @ 9.5%	\$ 3,553.00
Total Purchase Price (including delivery)	\$ 40,953.00

#### BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

The M/V Kalakala was constructed in Kirkland at the Lake Washington Shipyards in Houghton and launched in 1935.


With the M/V Kalakala now having been demolished in Tacoma, the City has an opportunity to purchase these items that were part of the historic ferry.

With its iconic design, the salvaged items from the Kalakala provide unique materials to be incorporated into public art on the Cross Kirkland Corridor.

KMC 3.85.210(a)(1) provides that the competitive process may be waived by the City Manager for purchases less than \$50,000 when the purchase is legitimately limited to a single source of supply.
