Subject: 2013 – 2018 Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP)
Set Public Hearing Date

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that City Council establish January 2, 2013 as the date to hold a public hearing on the proposed 2013-2018 TIP.

BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

The purpose of the hearing is to provide the public with an opportunity to comment and/or offer input on City transportation projects. Adoption of a six-year TIP is in accordance with RCW 35.77.010 and 47.26.210; the primary use of the TIP is to identify transportation projects which are eligible for federal, state and/or local funding.

For the most part, the projects that are identified in the 2013-2018 TIP mirror the transportation element of the 2013-2018 CIP, as proposed for approval by City Council at the December 11, 2012 meeting. The City's TIP also includes projects that are identified in the 117 street operating funds (loop detector replacement, and sidewalk repair, etc.).

The proposed 2013–2018 TIP will be discussed with the Kirkland Transportation Commission on December 5, 2012.
