



INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Kirkland will receive sealed bids in the office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, 123 Fifth Avenue, Kirkland, Washington, at 2:00 p.m. local time on March 15, 2013 for the project hereinafter referred to as:

Cross Kirkland Corridor Rail Removal Project Job No. 15-13-PW

At said time all bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in the form of a cashier's check or a bond issued on a form acceptable to your surety made payable to the City of Kirkland for a sum of not less than the greater of \$5,000 or five percent (5%) of the total bid amount for Schedule A. No bid shall be considered unless accompanied by such bid proposal deposit. Incomplete proposals and proposals received after the time stated above will not be considered. Faxed or emailed responses are not acceptable.

The work to be performed under these specifications consists of furnishing all labor, tools, materials, and equipment necessary for construction of the **Cross Kirkland Corridor Rail Removal Project**.

Specific work includes removal of all rail, ties and other track material (OTM) within the Cross Kirkland Corridor right-of-way from 108th Avenue NE to 132nd Ave NE with the exception of at-grade roadway crossings. Items of work include removal and salvage of the railway; removal and salvage/disposal of OTM; restoration of all disturbed areas to match preconstruction or better conditions; and providing, installing, and maintaining TESC BMPs to protect sensitive areas. The estimated cost for the removal of the materials is \$435,000 to \$535,000 and the estimated salvage value of the material to be removed is \$465,000 to \$572,000 for an estimated credit to the City of Kirkland in the amount of \$35,000.

As evidence that the Bidder meets the project specific supplemental bidders qualifications specified in Section 1-02.1, the apparent two lowest Bidders must submit documentation demonstrating compliance to the Contracting Agency, within 48 hours of the official Bid tabulation by the City.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to make the award to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder as best serves the interests of the City.

No bids may be withdrawn within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of the bid opening.

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
