



INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Kirkland will receive sealed bids in the office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, 123 Fifth Avenue, Kirkland, Washington, at 11:00 a.m. local time on Thursday, June 28, 2012 for the project hereinafter referred to as:

NE 53rd Street Sewermain Replacement; Job No. 13-12-PW, CIP No. CSS-0063

At said time all bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in the form of a cashier's check or a bond issued on a form acceptable to your surety made payable to the City of Kirkland for a sum of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid amount. No bid shall be considered unless accompanied by such bid proposal deposit. Incomplete proposals and proposals received after the time stated above will not be considered. Faxed or emailed responses are not acceptable.

The work to be performed under these specifications consists of furnishing all labor, tools, materials, and equipment necessary for construction of the NE 53rd Street Sewermain Replacement project. Generally, this project includes the replacement of sanitary sewer main pipe, connections, appurtenances, and manholes from 108th Avenue NE to 111th Avenue NE, with associated, necessary road and utility work, broken up into two main phases of work, the second phase including multiple work zones.

Specific work under Phase I includes, but is not limited to, replacement of an existing approximately 25-foot deep brick sanitary sewer manhole with a 54-inch diameter concrete manhole, reconstruction of two inside drops within this manhole, shoring, bypass pumping, removing and replacing approximately 16 feet of 12-inch D.I. water main, traffic control, permanent trench patching and restoration of the intersection. (Overlay, striping and c-curb installation are included in Phase II). Phase I shall be completed within ten (10) consecutive *calendar* days between the period of August 1, 2012 and August 23, 2012.

Specific work under Phase II includes, but is not limited to, replacement of approximately 150 lineal feet of sewer main by open cut trenching, and replacement of approximately 690 lineal feet of sewer main by pipe-bursting, replacement of three existing sanitary sewer manholes with 48-inch diameter concrete manholes, rehabilitating an existing approximately 17-foot deep brick sanitary sewer manhole with a "shotcrete" (sprayed concrete) lining, bypass pumping, traffic control, temporary and permanent trench patching, overlay, addition of c-curb, channelization revisions and associated project restoration as shown on the Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications.

The estimated cost for this project is approximately \$390,000 to \$430,000 including sales tax.

A pre-bid site walk-through of the project has been scheduled for Thursday, June 14, 2012. All interested parties shall meet at 10:00 a.m. at City Hall at 123 Fifth Avenue, Kirkland and sign-in at the Public Works front counter. Directions and a map of where to park will be provided.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to make the award to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder as best serves the interests of the City.

No bids may be withdrawn within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of the bid opening.
