This year, Kirkland will begin a two-year planning process that will help define the city's future. **Be a part of your community's future on June 8:**



Comprehensive Plan:

Plans for household and job growth through land use and infrastructure planning.



Cross Kirkland Corridor Master Plan:

Determines the future for a pedestrian and bicycle trail and a transit pathway.



Parks, Recreation and Open Space

(PROS) Plan: Articulates primary goals and philosophies of park and open space acquisition, park development and renovation.



Surface Water Master Plan: Identifies projects and programs that will support long-term progress for flood control, water quality improvement, and aquatic habitat protection and restoration.



Transportation Master Plan:

Guides transportation decisions and investments to support the City's long-term vision.



Totem Lake Park Master Plan:

Develops an overall plan for future park and recreation improvements to Totem Lake Park.



Capital Improvement Program / Capital Facilities Plan: Determines priorities and financing for maintaining Kirkland's roads, parks and other capital facilities.



Juanita Drive Corridor Study:

Improves the safety of cars, bikes and pedestrians along this scenic, north Kirkland corridor.
