CITY OF KIRKLAND NOTICE OF APPLICATION 4TH STREET SHORT PLAT, CASE NO. [SUB14-01295](#)

PROPOSAL: Michael Benes, the applicant, is requesting a Process I Short Plat Permit to subdivide one 12,293 square foot parcel into two parcels of 5,093 and 7,200 square feet in the RS 7.2 Zone using the small lot single family provisions. The existing house will be removed. The application was received by the City on July 10, 2014 and was deemed complete on July 30, 2014.
