CITY OF KIRKLAND NOTICE OF APPLICATION CHURCHILL HISTORIC SHORT PLAT, CASE NO. [SUB16-01572](#)

PROPOSAL: Dan Gillison of HCS Construction, the applicant, is requesting a Process I Short Plat Permit to divide one 10,723 SF parcel into a 5,042 SF and 5,681 SF parcel in the RS 7.2 Zone using the Historic Preservation provisions of KMC 22.28.048. The application was received by the City on June 28, 2016 and was deemed complete on July 26, 2016.

REVIEW PROCESS: The decision on this application will be made by the Planning Director. Prior to the decision, there is an opportunity for the public to submit written comments, as described below. The decision will be based on whether the application complies with Kirkland's Zoning code and other applicable codes.
