1. Prior to the commencement of work, the applicant shall submit final plans to the Planning Department showing existing and proposed topography of the stream bank in addition to full planting, monitoring and maintenance plans per the requirements of KZC Section 90.100.b. Additionally, the plans should ensure compliance with the culvert requirements of KZC Section 90.105.5 and ensure restoration of all affected sensitive areas and/or their buffers to pre-project condition or better.
2. Implement temporary erosion and sediment control plan and site protection measures, including construction phase fencing to protect significant trees.
3. Submit a copy of all approved permits from the agencies with jurisdiction.
