CITY OF KIRKLAND NOTICE OF APPLICATION LUX HOMES SHORT PLAT, CASE NO. SUB13-00538

PROPOSAL: Eve Riley, Geo Dimensions, Inc., the applicant, is requesting a Process I Short Plat Permit for a proposed 2 lot short plat of a 13,500 SF parcel, utilizing the small lot single-family provision of the subdivision code to create one parcel at 5,500 SF and retain the existing residence and one parcel at 8,000SF in the RS 7.2 Use Zone. The application was received by the City on April 10, 2013 and was deemed complete on April 15, 2013.

LOCATION: 11 21st Place.

NEIGHBORHOOD: Norkirk.

REVIEW PROCESS: The decision on this application will be made by the Planning Director. Prior to the decision, there is an opportunity for the public to submit written comments, as described below. The Director will also receive a report from the Planning Department staff making a recommendation on the application. The decision will be based on whether the application complies with Kirkland's Zoning Code and other applicable codes.
