CITY OF KIRKLAND NOTICE OF APPLICATION

NE 52ND STREET SHORT PLAT, CASE NO. SUB13-00205

PROPOSAL: Deanna Martin, The Blue Line Group, the applicant, is requesting a Process I Short Plat Permit to subdivide a .95 acre site into 4 lots within the RS 8.5 Zone. The application was received by the City on February 12, 2013 and was deemed complete on March 27, 2013.

LOCATION: 10400 NE 52nd Street

NEIGHBORHOOD: Central Houghton

REVIEW PROCESS: The decision on this application will be made by the Planning Director. Prior to the decision, there is an opportunity for the public to submit written comments, as described below. The Director will also receive a report from the Planning Department staff making a recommendation on the application. The decision will be based on whether the application complies with Kirkland's Zoning Code and other applicable codes.
