NOTICE OF APPLICATION
NEUPAUER STREAM BUFFER MODIFICATION, CASE NO. SAR12-01383**

PROPOSAL: Martin Neupauer, the applicant, is requesting a Process I Zoning Permit to reduce a Class B stream buffer by 1/3 in order to build a new single family home. The application was received by the City on November 8, 2012 and was deemed complete on January 23, 2013.

LOCATION: 117 19th Avenue.

NEIGHBORHOOD: Norkirk

REVIEW PROCESS: The decision on this application will be made by the Planning Director. Prior to the decision, there is an opportunity for the public to submit written comments, as described below. The Director will also receive a report from the Planning Department staff making a recommendation on the application. The decision will be based on whether the application complies with Kirkland's Zoning Code and other applicable codes.
