UP LAKE SHORT PLAT, CASE NO. [SUB15-00016](#)

PROPOSAL: Vasile Antemie, the applicant, is requesting a Process I Short Plat Permit to divide a 42,881 sq. ft. lot into 6 lots within the RSA 6 Zone and within the Holmes Point Overlay. The application was received by the City on January 5, 2015 and was deemed complete on September 7, 2016.
