



## **PUBLIC HEARING & COMMENT PERIOD NOTICE**

### **KIRKLAND SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM UPDATE**

**A public hearing will be held by the Washington State Department of Ecology at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, February 9, 2010 at the Kirkland City Hall located at 123 – 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Kirkland, Washington.**

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment on the City's proposed 2009 Shoreline Master Program (SMP) Comprehensive Update. The proposed SMP update revises all aspects of the existing shoreline master program, including but not limited to:

- Goals, Policies and Regulations,
- Shoreline Environment Designations,
- Administrative Procedures, Definitions
- Provides new provisions to bring the program into compliance with state law.

Authority to amend the City's Shoreline Master Program is based on Chapter 90.58 RCW, the State Shoreline Management Act, and its implementing rules including Chapter 173-26 WAC, the State Master Program Approval/Amendment Procedures and Master Program Guidelines.

**The public comment period will be open from February 1, 2010 through March 5, 2010.** Comments can be provided at this hearing.
