July 8, 2009 Update: The contractor is scheduled to do 2 nights of work to complete the asphalt paving. Work will include closing the intersection at 124th Avenue NE and NE 124th Street:

- Wednesday, July 15 9:00 pm to Thursday, July 16 5:00 am; and
- Thursday, July 16 9:00 pm to Friday, July 17 5:00 am.

Continuous local access will remain open to all adjacent properties and patrons. A detour will be set up (see diagram on reverse side), but emergency vehicles will always be able to get through. Sidewalks are scheduled to be complete by Monday, July 13. Pavement markings are scheduled to be installed by Tuesday, July 21.

In the Totem Lake Neighborhood: Traffic congestion relief is on its way to the intersection of NE 124th Street and 124th Avenue NE in Totem Lake neighborhood with three additional vehicular lanes, bicycle lanes, concrete sidewalks, and pavement markings at the intersection of NE 124th Street and 124th Avenue NE. The project will also provide a surface water quality and drainage control system.

When: Construction is scheduled to start early in April, and last for approximately 5 months. Hours of operation are M-F 7:00 am to 6:00 pm except in the event of an emergency or if a night time shut-down is required.

What to Expect: During the construction process, there may be inconveniences associated with driving through the work zone. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained throughout the construction process. The contractor is required to backfill and/or cover their work at the end of each day so there will be no open trenches left over night. The paving portion of this project is weather dependent which may result in a delay of the completion of the project.

How You Can Help: The City appreciates your cooperation in ensuring the roadway remains unobstructed. The contractor will be posting "No Parking" signs along the street where work is planned.


