**Who:** The City of Kirkland along with the contractor, Lakeside Industries, will be resurfacing 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue/NE 87<sup>th</sup> Street from 6<sup>th</sup> Street to 116<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE.

**Where:** The construction map on the back of this flyer indicates the area being resurfaced.

**When:** Construction is scheduled to begin the week of October 5 and may continue into the week of October 12. Schedule information will be posted on the City's website [www.ci.kirkland.wa.us](http://www.ci.kirkland.wa.us) (search Street Preservation). It is possible that construction schedules may change due to weather conditions.

**What to Expect:** Over the past several months, City street crews have been repairing damaged pavement in preparation for the resurfacing. The contractor also has replaced sections of broken curb and sidewalk, and installed sidewalk ramps that meet the current requirements of the Americans With Disabilities Act.

Inconvenience caused by construction will be minimized to the extent possible. However, some delays and temporary lane closures will be necessary in order to complete the work. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times throughout the work. Lakeside Industries will schedule activities around regular garbage/recycling pick-up schedules. Door hangers will be distributed to all adjacent residents and businesses within 24-hours of paving.

Business access will be maintained throughout the resurfacing. However, while paving work is occurring directly in front of driveways, access may be delayed until the new pavement surface is compacted. The Project Inspector will be on site to help coordinate access and answer any questions on the day of work. Water is harmful to all pavement repair treatments. Please avoid washing vehicles or watering adjacent lawns on the date work is scheduled.

**Why:** Preventative maintenance not only prolongs the life of a street but saves money by improving the street before it reaches the final state of its life when rapid deterioration occurs. After the overlay, the street will look very much like it did when it was new, and will again be able to withstand the effects of traffic and weather. Preventative maintenance saves the taxpayers money.

#### How You Can Help:

Your cooperation in ensuring the area of roadway affected by the project is not obstructed with vehicles or other items is greatly appreciated. 
