

#### **APRIL 6 UPDATE**

Marshbank Construction hopes to restore two of Park Lane's vital pedestrian access points this week. By building sidewalk sections on the west block's northeast and southeast corners—as well as a curb ramp—Marshbank will be able to re-open the Park Lane crossing that connects Starbucks to the Lake and Central parking lot, as well as the crossing that connects the west side of Lake Street to Park Lane. Marshbank and its subcontractors will also pour the concrete that will form the walls for two of the three bio-retention cells, as well as for the curb along the west block's south side.

Once that concrete is placed, Marshbank's subcontractor will be ready to lay the brick that will form a portion of the south side's walking area.

On the northside, Marshbank will continue this week removing the paved walkway and replacing it with a temporary boardwalk. This will prepare its workers for the concrete banding Marshbank hopes to pour this week along the west block's northside. Marshbank's workers will continue to usher customers into stores if and when possible.

Crews will also be placing five light standards along the west block's north side. They placed five along the south side last week.
