





# ROAD CLOSED AHEAD

To expedite progress and ensure completion on a variety of infrastructure projects, Kirkland's contractors are closing sections of roads. This map details those sections.

## LEGEND

-  First Street, between Seventh and Ninth avenues, remains closed while Rodarte Construction upgrades the sewer main beneath the street. The one- and two-block closures will continue as Rodarte progresses north, toward 16th Avenue.
-  The northernmost westbound lane of Northeast 85th Street, between 114th Avenue Northeast and Sixth Street, will close between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Aug. 23 and 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Aug. 24. The closure allows Kirkland's streets division to repair and repave damaged pavement.
-  Sections of Kirkland Way and Kirkland Avenue remain closed this week from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Thursday for an upgrade to downtown's water delivery system. Oceanside Construction is continuing to provide access to emergency vehicles, local residents, workers and customers. Kirkland Avenue will open periodically. However, Kirkland Way will remain closed during work hours until mid-October.
-  Kirkland's Northeast 52nd Street sidewalk contractor will close for one week a 200-foot section of Northeast 52nd Street. The closure allows Kamins Construction needs to build the nine-foot soldier pile wall that will prevent the north slope from eroding. Kamins will close Northeast 52nd Street daily, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Aug. 28 through Sept. 1. The street will remain open after work hours.
