### **Project:** Park Lane Phase I: Terrewalk sidewalk panels and Silva Cell tree

**What:** Park Lane Phase I addresses immediate concerns around sidewalk buckling, cracking and breaking. These interim improvements will be done while the design is completed and funding is sought for Phase II (the Flexible Festival Street Concept). Construction of Park Lane's Phase I improvements include twenty three Terrewalk sidewalk panel locations and one Silva Cell tree replacement.

**Where:** Sidewalks on the north and south side of Park Lane between Lake Street and Main Street. The contractor is scheduled to start construction on the southwest section of sidewalk and work east. The second half of construction will start at the northeast section and move west. **Who:** The contractor, Pacific Northwest Earthworks, will be working with the City of Kirkland.

**When:** Construction activity is expected to start the week of April 5 and be complete by the end of April. Typical hours of operation are Monday-Friday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

**What to Expect:** The City will strive to keep construction impacts to a minimum while sidewalk segments are removed and the Terrewalk Panels are installed. In order to complete the project as efficiently as possible, the contractor will be restricting parking in two stalls near the construction area. No-parking signs will be posted 24 hours in advance of all parking restrictions. During construction, there may be inconvenience associated with driving through the work zone; traffic control and flagging operations will be in effect. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained throughout the construction process.
