Call to Order

Chair Wherry called meeting to order at 7:35 a.m.

Approval of December meeting notes

Meeting notes were approved unanimously.

Public Comment

Julie Metter commented on KDA reorganization.

February 3 study session

Jack Wherry asked Board members to contact City Councilmembers to discuss topics for study session; each board member chose a councilmember to contact. Discussion on the topics and content for the study session followed, with the following topics being identified.

- Rollout of free/evening parking
- Parking requirements for legacy buildings
- Mechanisms for securing funding
- Expanding pay parking
- Opportunities for adding supply
- Park Smart
- Summary of survey data
