Call to Order

Chair Wherry called meeting to order at 7:30 a.m.

Approval of November & December meeting notes

Approved unanimously

Elect Chair and Vice-Chair

Castleberry nominated Wherry to remain as Chair, seconded by Torrance. Wherry nominated Castleberry to Vice-Chair, seconded by Peterson.

Report to City Council

PAB needs have more discussion before memo is complete. This will include not being too specific in the solutions, and looking to council to move forward with some kind of contingency plan in place.

Parking Ticket Report

Board requested to change "revenue" to read "amount".

License Plate Recognition

The traffic department is looking at purchasing a License Plate Recognition device from Genetec. Joe Gardner presented all the functionalities with many examples of how it could fit well with downtown Kirkland's enforcement needs. Peterson motioned, seconded by Castleberry to make a recommendation to City Council to approve the purchase of the device. A written recommendation from the PAB will be sent to Lieutenant Murray.

Update on Park Lane

Kari and Gina presented the stakeholder's preferred concept for Park Lane. Phase 1 will include replacing most of the damaged sidewalks with rubber sidewalks, and a replacement of one tree with a silva cell hollow structure. Phase 2 is not funded, but once funding is made available, the concept includes no curbs, street and curb will blend; four parking stalls will be lost on West Park Lane and the 15 stalls on East Park Lane will be parallel rather than angled.
