Work Items

1. License reader: Projected start date is June. City is working out interfacing details with the IT department. Members would like to know what data can be collected such as occupancy by block, movement of vehicles, and license plate gathering.
2. Pay Parking: EDC recommends the board hold off for now with making any all-day pay parking charges. Instead gather data, work with businesses this summer season; and then seek council direction perhaps in the fall. Develop observational points in the outreach process. With no immediate pay parking changes, the members proposed changes to the existing signage by adding entrance signs: PAY PARKING AFTER 5PM, removal of the "Free Parking" from signs, and adding "ALL STALLS" underneath existing signage. Staff will let stakeholders know the status.
3. Parking requirements: No discussion at this time.
