Call to Order

Approval of May meeting notes

Meeting notes were approved unanimously.

Memo to Council

Further discussions are needed about the finance plan and Park Smart, therefore, the PAB decided to postpone submitting their status memo to Council on June 16th, but rather on July 21st. Memo will be due on July 9th. One suggestion was made about the commercial property owner's buy-in to the finance plan and perhaps a meeting be held by the end of the year. Board agreed that the KDA/merchants need buy-in to the employee parking problem which has become the City's problem instead.

Antique Mart Parking

Staff reported on the public parking opportunity at the Antique Mart site. Parking options were presented and the board agreed to "Tami's Choice" and keeping in mind future monthly parking possibly becoming available.

Marilyn Dillard Visit

Owner of the Antique Mart site expressed her needs for the property which included receiving a flat monthly rate per stall /per month rather than a percentage of net revenue, and for her tenant to have 10 spaces closest to the building for the Antique Mart patrons. Both Sandi Hines and Ellen Miller-Wolfe offered to put this topic on the agenda of both the Economic Development Committee and the Finance Sub-committee meetings, on June 22nd and June 20th respectively, prior to the Council agenda meeting on July 7th.
