Call to Order

Approval of June meeting notes

One change, under Antique Mart, add (Antique Mall).

Welcome Jennifer Lindsay, new PAB member

Currently Jennifer is the City Manager for Diamond Parking on the Eastside for parking in both the private and municipal operations; to include downtown Kirkland.

Antique Mart Parking

Status update about the parking agreement. Given the City's current financial climate, and after a couple of City committee meetings, it was determined that the City does not want to commit to an agreement based on a flat monthly rate per stall, but rather an "up-to" rate after monthly expenses are met. At this time, no agreement has been reached. The PAB endorsed the City securing this parking location.

Part Smart

PAB agrees with some kind of Park Smart modification to include putting Ginger back on the street full-time. However, the Park Smart program, in whole, would need to remain "as is" until Council accepts pay parking on-street.

PAB memo to Council

Jack will present the PAB memo to Council on July 21st under a Special Meeting. Board agreed to memo revisions to include;

1. Finance: funding of new supply/partner with developers
2. Code changes to Park Smart Ordinance and revise Park Smart section
3. New pay parking in lots (going well)
4. Recommend holding other stakeholders group meetings. Reconvene stakeholders to be made up of business, property and commercial owners to develop a finance plan. Perhaps look at Lake and Central location again.
