Call to Order

Peterson shared about an alternative Pay by Space parking meter. IPS will present a demo presentation on July 28th at City Hall. Members and staff are encouraged to attend.

Approval of June meeting notes

Moved by Loos, seconded by Dueker, approved unanimously.

Park & Main update

Staff provided data showing revenue and transactions. To-date only one person purchased the \$80 monthly special. Dueker requested the same reporting data for both Lake & Central and Marina parking lots.

Potential code amendments

Planning is seeking the PAB's recommendations on two potential changes, 1) to the current code of 1.7 to 1 stall per bedroom, and 2) to change the single parking requirement for shopping centers. Planning will provide a draft with options for the PAB to review.

Study session debrief

PAB received positive feedback from Council. The items on pay and seasonal parking will need to be brought back again. Council is looking for a report on the library event parking on July 18th, and the upcoming joint meeting with the Planning Commission. PAB will discuss creating guiding principles with a vision of downtown in mind, and how the components of parking management strategies fit with the long-term parking goals and plan.

Planning asked the board to prepare an introductory cover memo to the Parking Requirements document for their joint meeting on July 22nd.
