**Call to Order**

**Public Comment**

Roxanne Louise, downtown employee for 36 years. Shared parking thoughts and concerns; mostly on employees parking at Lakeshore Plaza.

**Acceptance of March and April meeting notes.**

**Library garage maintenance**

Maintenance department shared the strong need for something to be done with the elevator and the CO system in the parking garage. Both are very old and need replacement, not to mention the years of vandalism which has taken place in the elevator.

**Work Items**

1. License reader: PAB will be looking for data from the reader this summer to see how parking is being used. The start date is for sometime in June.
2. Pay Parking: Staff discussed what the public outreach involvement plan could entail in order to inform Council this fall. Both patron and merchant feedback and reader data obtained will be reported.
3. Parking requirements: Member Dueker shared on the meeting he attended about Park Place. A start date is not certain. The City will probably not need to lease evening parking, however perhaps a neighborhood parking program will be needed.

**Other**

Lakeshore Plaza re-configuration of the parking lot is not feasible. In order to add additional parking spaces, the cost to re-do does not pencil out enough to warrant so few net parking stalls.

**Park Lane parking stalls**

The fifteen stalls located on Park Lane east are temporarily open for public use through July or until the King County project starts up.

**Load/Taxi zone**

Staff presented two potential loading/taxi zones, one on Lake St and the other on Kirkland Ave. "Taxi" signage is required by the KMC. PD suggested an additional Taxi zone is needed on Central Way near the Time Out bar.

**Wednesday Market**

The south entrance to the Lake & Central lot will now remain open. However, between 12-2 pm and 7-8 pm two reserved stalls in the parking lot will be used for load/unloading; signage will be posted in advance.
