What: Public Hearing to Rename the I-405 Bridge over NE 116th Street

When: Wednesday, June 24, 2009 at 6 p.m.

Where: Council Chambers, Kirkland City Hall

Why: On June 22, 2007, Kollin Nielson tragically lost his life due to a drunk driving incident while working on the Washington State Department of Transportation's Interstate 405 Kirkland Nickel Stage 1 Widening Project.

Kollin was thirty years old and an employee of Kiewit Pacific Construction Company. Kollin is survived by his wife, Sara, and his young son.

The I-405 Bridge is proposed to be renamed the “**Kollin Nielson Memorial Bridge.**”
