



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

PHASING | “WHERE WE ARE GOING”

THE PARK WILL BE DEVELOPED IN PHASES...

Phase 1: Work will commence in 2020 and includes a stormwater retrofit project at the lower fields and restoration with synthetic turf and field lighting.

The primary driver of this phase is stormwater improvements to the overall drainage basin, funded by an Ecology Grant.



PHASING | “WHERE WE ARE GOING”

SUBSEQUENT PHASES ARE FUNDING DEPENDENT.

Phase 2: Subsequent phases are dependent on funding and include improvements such as a new restroom, new picnic shelters, expanded play area, parking, trails, etc.



OPTION 1 | "WANDERING WOODLANDS"

FEATURES:

- ✓ 60 STALLS (NO PARKING EXPANSION)
- ✓ RESTROOM REMODEL
- ✓ INFORMAL PLAY HILL
- ✓ PICNIC SHELTERS COMBINED WITH PLAY AREA
- ✓ EXPANDED PLAY AREA
- ✓ URBAN FOREST - NATIVE FOREST
- ✓ DISC GOLF (3-HOLES)



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OPTION 2 | “PLAY FOREST”

FEATURES:

- ✓ 80 PARKING STALLS (20 STALL ADDITION)
- ✓ NEW RESTROOM
- ✓ PLAY HILL - STRUCTURED FEATURE
- ✓ PICNIC SHELTERS - TUCKED ALONG FOREST EDGE
- ✓ URBAN FOREST - ARBORETUM COLLECTION
- ✓ STORAGE BUILDING - MEDIUM SIZE, AT MU FIELD LEVEL
- DISC GOLF - NOT INCLUDED



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OPTION 3 | “BOULEVARD STROLL”

FEATURES:

- ✓ 120 PARKING STALLS (60 STALL ADDITION)
- ✓ NEW RESTROOM
- ✓ PLAY HILL - SECONDARY ELEMENT
- ✓ PICNIC SHELTERS - TUCKED UNDER TREES
- ✓ URBAN FOREST - MULTIPLE ALLEES
- ✓ STORAGE BUILDING - LARGE SIZE, AT MU FIELD LEVEL
- DISC GOLF - NOT INCLUDED



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
