EMERGENCY VEHICLE ACCESS

Keep emergency access lanes clear at all times, including during load-in and load-out. Don't block fire hydrants or fire connections.



TENTS & CANOPIES

Tents, canopies, and other equipment should not block manholes, water valves, or access hatches.



WEIGHTS REQUIRED

A minimum of twenty-five pounds per canopy leg is required in all weather conditions.



SIDEWALKS

Keep sidewalks clear of displays and equipment. Sidewalks and pedestrian areas should provide a clear path of travel.



PROPANE

Propane fuel is limited to one 5-gallon cylinder per cooking unit with no more than 3 cylinders per 30 feet of booth space. Cylinders should be isolated by fencing or enclosure and properly secured.




FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

All booths with, or adjacent to, heat producing equipment must have a fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 2A:10BC. Extinguishers should be in good condition, fully charged, seals intact and certified within the last year.




GENERATORS

Place generators at least 20 feet away from temporary structures like tents and canopies. Protect them from the general public with fencing or other enclosure.



FATS, OILS, & GREASE

Wastewater, including fats, oils, and grease (F.O.G.) should be collected and disposed of off-site. Do not dump F.O.G. in garbage cans, restroom facilities, storm drains or the public sewer system.



PLASTIC BAG BAN

The plastic bag ban restricts use of single-use, disposable plastic carryout bags. There are exceptions for take-out food, produce and meat, bulk food, flowers and items where moisture is an issue.



PARK RULES

Do not drive or park vehicles on lawns, pathways, sidewalks, or other walkways that are for pedestrians. This rule also applies during load-in and load-out.
