

PROJECT UPDATE



CARING FOR YOUR INFRASTRUCTURE TO KEEP KIRKLAND HEALTHY, SAFE AND VIBRANT



Kirkland will upgrade water main on sections of three streets: 104th Avenue Northeast, between Northeast 109th Street and Northeast 113th Place; and on Northeast 112th Street and Northeast 113th Place between 104th and 106th avenues northeast.

Water system upgrades improve capacity, durability

The work will require contractor to trench into 104th, 112th and 113th

WHAT: A City of Kirkland contractor begins upgrades mid-March on three sections of aging water main in the Juanita neighborhood. CR Construction will replace more than 2,000 linear feet of eight-inch concrete pipes beneath Northeast 113th Street, Northeast 112th Street and 104th Avenue Northeast with eight-inch ductile iron pipes, which are more flexible and durable than concrete.

After installation, the contractor will repave and patch the sections of street it affected by the water main upgrades. The map on this page highlights the sections of water main Kirkland will be upgrading.

WHEN: Construction begins the week of March 18 and will

continue until September. The contractor will work between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT: The contractor will provide access for local residents, mail delivery, garbage pick-up and emergency vehicles.

■ The contractor’s ability to pave will rely directly on forecasted periods of dry weather. Rain and forecasted rain will delay the paving process
