



## Fire Station 25 renovation temporarily relocates responders

Department will maintain target response times

**OCTOBER 2017** — Finn Hill residents will receive emergency response for nine months from former Fire Station 24 while the City upgrades Fire Station 25 on Juanita Drive and 76th Place Northeast.

yellow to alert travelers that they are passing an active fire station. The lights will flash red when fire engines are entering or exiting the fire station.

- Fire Station 25 responds to two calls per day, on average.

**WHY:** The renovation will retrofit 43-year-old Fire Station 25 for seismic activity and modernize it by replacing all of its existing mechanical, plumbing and electrical systems with energy-efficient, code-compliant systems. It will improve firefighters' workplace health by separating the decontamination area and engine bay from the places where firefighters work and live.

- Construction hours are 7 a.m. - 6 p.m., weekdays.

- Construction will not affect access for local residents, mail delivery, garbage pick-up and emergency vehicles.

- Fire stations 21 and 27 will continue to supplement emergency response for Finn Hill-area emergencies.

**WHEN:** Senior Project Coordinator Anneke Davis expects the project to be complete by July 2018.
