

PROJECT UPDATE



CARING FOR YOUR INFRASTRUCTURE TO KEEP KIRKLAND HEALTHY, SAFE AND VIBRANT



The City of Kirkland is upgrading the water and sewer mains beneath Kirkland Avenue, between Railroad Avenue and 116th Avenue Northeast. The work will require lane-closures.

Water, sewer project to affect Kirkland Ave

Upgrades will improve systems' capacity and ensure its durability

WHAT: A water and sewer main upgrade project will require some lane-closures this fall on Kirkland Avenue, between 116th Avenue Northeast and Railroad Avenue. There, the City of Kirkland is planning to upgrade 1,500 linear feet of eight-inch concrete pipe to 12-inch PVC pipe. The City will also replace 1,550 linear feet of eight-inch concrete sewer pipe with 12-inch PVC pipe.

After installation, the contractor will patch and repave Kirkland Avenue.

WHEN: Kirkland's project engineers are expecting the upgrade to begin by spring 2019 and to continue into until 2020. The contractor will work between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., and between

Monday and Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT: The contractor will provide access for local residents, mail delivery, garbage pick-up and emergency vehicles.

- One—or both—of Kirkland Avenue's lanes will close at times.
- Rain and forecasted rain will delay the paving schedule.
