


# PROJECT UPDATE



CARING FOR YOUR INFRASTRUCTURE TO KEEP KIRKLAND HEALTHY, SAFE AND VIBRANT



The City of Kirkland is replacing in March and April a 750-foot section of root-choked stormwater pipe. Construction on the project will last for two months.

## Storm system upgrade coming to Pleasant Bay

### New pipes will add capacity and restore integrity to existing storm system

**WHAT:** Kirkland's contractor will be replacing a 750-foot section of root-choked, eight-inch concrete stormwater pipe with an 18-inch PVC pipe. To complete the project, Pacific Sitework will also replace a 15-foot section of concrete water pipe with a ductile iron pipe.

**WHY:** The project will increase the stormwater system's capacity and will reduce local flooding.

**WHEN:** Construction begins the week of March 4 and will continue into early May. Crews will be working eight hours a day between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the Pleasant Bay Apartments complex and between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Lake Washington Boulevard.

**WHAT TO EXPECT:** Water will be unavailable to the Pleasant Bay Apartments for up to one work-day while contracted crews connect the new system to adjacent homes and buildings. The

City of Kirkland will notify residents about any water outage 48 hours before it occurs.

- Flaggers will direct traffic on Lake Washington Boulevard and in the apartment complex while Pacific Sitework's workers connect the new stormwater system.

- A short section of sidewalk along the east side of Lake Washington Boulevard and along the entrance to Pleasant Bay Apartments will be closed for three days while Pacific Sitework connects the stormwater pipes in Lake Washington Boulevard

- The contractor will ensure access for local residents, mail delivery, garbage pick-up and emergency vehicles.

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
