

SPILL RESPONSE

1. Evaluate the situation.

Call City of Kirkland Spill Response 24/7

Notify your manager or owner of the spill.

2. Put on Personal Protective Equipment

3. Stop the source of the spill.

i.e. Tip containers upright, plug holes, etc.

4. Protect storm drain(s).

Place absorbent booms around the storm drain and in spill path.



5. Clean Spill Using Spill Kit Materials

6. Dispose of cleanup materials properly and restock the kit.
