

## Front Porch: Example Plan Sizes

A cottage porch should have three exposed sides, be no shorter than 7 ft on any side, and be equal to or greater than $64 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$ in area. The ideal front porch has dimensions greater than 7 ft and has an area larger than $64 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$. Larger porches provide spaces to entertain and enjoy fresh air, allowing residents to socialize with neighbors passing through. Porches with stairs and doors situated on one end are ideal, as they do not create two seperate spaces, therefore fostering a better layout for entertaining guests.

## Example A

-7 ft by 9.5 ft , area of $66.5 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$

- Just over the minimum porch size and does not supply much space for outdoor furniture.
Example B:
-7 ft by 14 ft , area of $98 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$
- The stairway and door bisect the porch, creating two smaller spaces.

Example C:

- 19 ft by 14 ft , area of $26 \mathrm{ft}^{2}$
- Unified space that is large enough for an outdoor table.
