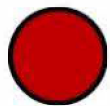

For a limited time, individuals with bench warrants in a district or municipal court in King County can participate in the Back on Track Program to quash qualified warrants through a new warrant amnesty program available from April 1 through June 30, 2021.

While each court has its own procedure for the program, many warrants under \$5,000 will be handled administratively with the warrant immediately removed and a hearing scheduled to address the case. Warrants over \$5,000 and those that involve Domestic Violence, No Contact Orders, DUIs, Physical Control, Reckless Driving or Negligent Driving 1stDegree (amended from a DUI), no matter the amount of the warrant, will be referred to the judge for consideration.

“This is a great opportunity for court customers in King County to get back on track,” stated Bothell Municipal Court Judge Mara Rozzano. “With COVID-19 restrictions, we understand there has been a lot of confusion about how to access the court system, and many of our customers have been understandably worried about their health and safety. This program will allow individuals with qualified warrants to immediately have them removed, set a new court date and work on getting their cases resolved.”

Individuals with bench warrants should contact the specific court where the warrant was issued. Requests to quash warrants can be made by phone or in writing. The court may require a photocopy or photo of valid State-issued identification, updated contact information, including address, email address, and phone number, and the citation/case number. If the citation/case number is not known, the court will be able to assist the customer in obtaining that information. All district and municipal courts in King County have options to interact with the court that do not require in-person contact, including virtual hearings where clients can participate online and/or via telephone.

“This pandemic has affected all of us in many ways, including the court system. Therefore, every district and municipal court in King County is participating in this mutually beneficial program,” observed Judge Kara Murphy from Renton Municipal Court. “A regional effort ensures all individuals with qualified warrants have the same opportunity, regardless of which court their cases are filed. It also provides a seamless way for us to spread the word that courts are open for business, with safe, remote options online and over the phone for people to address their cases.”

This opportunity is being provided on a limited basis - from April 1 through June 30, 2021. Individuals who qualify are strongly encouraged to participate and contact courts today. The following courts are actively participating in the Back on Track program:
