POSTION	Green Kirkland Steward (Lead Volunteer)
<b>REPORTS TO:</b>	Green Kirkland Partnership staff
LOCATION:	City of Kirkland parks, WA (various locations)
POSTION TYPE:	Volunteer, with 2+ year term of service expected
POSITION DESCRIPTION:	The Green Kirkland Partnership (GKP) is a program to restore over 400 acres of natural areas in the City of Kirkland parks. Green Kirkland Stewards coordinate with GKP staff to adopt an area of a City park with natural space and lead long-term volunteer based restoration efforts that make on the ground improvements a reality. Stewards receive valuable training and access to the resources necessary to conduct their restoration work.
SPECIFIC DUTIES:	<ul> <li>Serve as key contact person for Green Kirkland Staff</li> <li>Coordinate volunteer restoration events and activities in designated natural area/park</li> <li>Supervise and support on-site Restoration volunteers</li> <li>Submit timely event and materials requests, sign-in sheets and work logs</li> <li>Coordinate with GKP staff to develop yearly restoration and planting plans</li> <li>Attend New Steward Orientation or complete new steward requirements with GKP staff person</li> <li>Attend training events</li> </ul>
REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:	<ul> <li>Ability to coordinate and host at least 2 volunteer events per year. Expected to host up to 25 Restoration volunteers on own; occasionally co-host larger groups (25 to 150) with GKP staff or contractors.</li> <li>Ability to organize and manage diverse activities and set priorities; flexible under pressure</li> <li>Ability to develop and maintain positive working relationships with staff, volunteers, donors, community supporters and Kirkland residents</li> <li>Ability to work under physically demanding conditions including cold and wet weather</li> </ul>
DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:	<ul> <li>Experience coordinating and leading events</li> <li>Knowledge of natural areas restoration and invasive species removal practices</li> <li>Knowledge of Pacific Northwest native flora and common invasive plants</li> <li>Experience with teaching youth or adult volunteers in an environmental education setting</li> <li>Good organizational, communication, interpersonal and computer skills</li> </ul>
