### FREE TO RECYCLE



#### Styrofoam™ Blocks

White foam / expanded polystyrene blocks  
All items must be clean and dry. Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol.

**NOT ACCEPTED**

Urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation. Dispose as trash.

#### Bulky Wood

- ▶ Branches - 6" diameter or larger
- ▶ Clean wood & plywood
- ▶ Pallets
- ▶ Logs

All wood should be unpainted, untreated, and unstained. Lay a tarp under materials for easy removal.

**LIMIT:** 2 loads per household

**NOT ACCEPTED**

Painted/stained wood, particle board, small branches, brush

#### Scrap Metal

- ▶ Appliances
- ▶ Gas mowers
- ▶ Bicycles
- ▶ Auto parts
- ▶ (drain gas/oil)
- ▶ Ferrous & non ferrous metals
- ▶ Engines
- ▶ Barbecues

**NOT ACCEPTED**

Insulated; rubber/oil-coated; contained paint, oil, chemicals, gas, or hazardous materials; electrical ballasts; sealed drums

#### Electronic Peripherals

- ▶ Printers
- ▶ Mice
- ▶ VCRs
- ▶ Cell phones
- ▶ Keyboards
- ▶ DVD/blu-ray players
- ▶ Microwaves
- ▶ Fax & scanners

**NOT ACCEPTED**

TVs, computers, laptops, computer monitors, tablets, e-readers and portable DVD players. Find free drop-off locations for these items at [ecyclewashington.org](http://ecyclewashington.org).

### FREE SHREDDING



Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Staples OK. No binder clips.

**LIMIT:** 4 file-size (12"x12"x16") boxes or equivalent quantity.

**CASH ONLY**

### CHARGE TO RECYCLE



#### Mattresses, Box Springs

Mattresses and box springs only, any size. All items must be clean and dry. Please cover in the event of rain.

**FEE:** \$15 each

**NOT ACCEPTED**

Futons, wet or soiled items, furniture, frames. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item.



#### Household Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers

**FEE:** \$35 each



#### Refrigerators, Freezers

**FEE:** \$30 each



#### Water Heaters

**FEE:** \$5 each that still has insulation coating



#### Porcelain Toilets, Sinks, Tubs

Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.

**FEE:** \$15 each toilet or sink (no fee for tubs)

#### Tires

Bias ply, steel belted, studded tires

**FEES FOR PASSENGER TIRES:**

\$0 / tire not on rim (first four)  
\$1.50 / each tire not on rim after first four  
\$3.00 / tire on rim

**FEES FOR TRUCK TIRES:**

\$9 / large truck tire  
\$18 / truck tire on rim

**NOT ACCEPTED**

Oversized tires



#### Propane Tanks

Empty residential tanks

**FEE:** \$5 each

Empty camping stove tanks

**FEE:** \$1 each

**CASH ONLY**

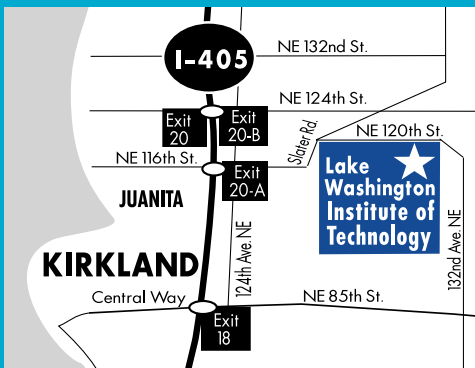
