Dear Teresa,

Thank you for your interest in our work. We are pleased to provide a proposal for two new sculptures in addition to the four that are already on exhibit on Park Lane. We have enjoyed working with the City of Kirkland and the KCAC and hope to continue the partnership.

We propose two sculptures, of similar size (6.5' high x 4' w x 4' d) and style to those already on exhibit, and with the same objective to highlight awareness of Covid-19 and to reflect the Kirkland community. The sculptures would be made of $\frac{3}{4}$ " plywood, painted with acrylic paint, and sealed to withstand the weather.

We propose that one of the sculptures represents a doctor or nurse and that the other represents a parent holding a young child. Those themes would provide an opportunity to acknowledge the hard work and contributions of our medical professionals, and to also acknowledge that families are being affected in many ways by Covid-19, from work adjustments to online schooling, to restrictions on activities.

The cost for installing the two sculptures would be \$6,000. The artist will retain all rights to, and ownership of, the work.

Timeline of work:

Contract approval

Installation: Five weeks after contract approval (or earlier as completed)

Deinstallation: March 27, 2021 (under the new agreement, all six sculptures would be de-installed at the same time)

Artists will be responsible to check work periodically throughout the installation period.
