4. ITEMS FROM THE AUDIENCE (1:59)

Liz Hunt commented on concerns regarding passenger pickup and drop-off that is part of the I-405/NE 85th St Inline Bus Rapid Transit Station and Interchange project.

5. NEW COMMISSIONER INTRODUCTIONS (5:51)

6. CROSS KIRKLAND CORRIDOR/EASTLINK CROSSING STUDY AT 132ND AVENUE NE (8:40)

Daniel Rawlings, Transportation Engineer; Tresia Gonzalez, Senior Consultant, Parametrix; and Schaun Valdovinos, Principal, V+M Structural Design, provided a presentation on crossing concept alternatives and screening criteria for evaluating the crossing concept alternatives. Mr. Rawlings, Ms. Gonzalez, Mr. Valdovinos, and staff gathered comments and answered questions from the Commission, which will inform crossing concept alternatives presented and recommended to City Council.

7. ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE AND VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN (53:18)
