Topics included performance monitoring, public engagement, project list development and prioritization, estimated revenues and project costs, and project packaging. Commission provided input on many aspects of the TSP, including performance monitoring, data, safety, transit, and gave direction to staff to present the first draft of the projects list to the Council using a top-to-bottom prioritization scheme instead of project packaging.
