### **Minutes of Regular Meeting**

1. CALL TO ORDER (0:00)

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES (0:01)

September 24, 2025, Regular Meeting Minutes were moved for approval by Commissioner Katherine Casseday and seconded by Commissioner David Tan.

5. CIP UPDATE (0:02)
