1. CALL TO ORDER (0:02)

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES (0:03)

April 22nd, 2026, Regular Meeting Minutes were moved for approval by Commissioner Magee and seconded by Commissioner Hanson.

4. ITEMS FROM THE AUDIENCE (0:01)

5. KING COUNTY METRO UPDATE (0:04)

A presentation was provided by King County Metro staff, Amanda Pleasant Brown, Brian Henry, and Ryan Whitney, on the 2026 Spring Service Change, the K-Line Rapid Ride planning and Metro Flex service. The Commissioners inquired about different services offered by Metro, and timing for future service changes and new projects.

6. PARKING MAP PILOT (0:26)

The Commission received a presentation from Kim Scrivner, Senior Transportation Planner, on the new real-time parking map, the city is piloting the summer of 2026. The map will show vacant and occupied parking stalls in Downtown Kirkland and two waterfront park parking lots. The Commission provided feedback on the look and usability of the map and suggestions for other links to other city websites.

7. TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIC PLAN (TSP) METRICS (01:10)

A presentation was provided by Blair Daly, Transportation Program Coordinator, on the updated metrics to monitor progress with implementing the Transportation Strategic Plan. The new set of metrics were adopted as part of the TSP so the 2026 metrics is the first data collection and analysis since the TSP was adopted in 2024. The Commission provided feedback on the look of the metrics and trends and needs the city should consider investing more in.

8. STAFF REPORTS (2:03)

- The 85th St Shared Use Path is planned for opening mid-June and the CKC is planned but pending full opening the upcoming weekend.
- There is a ribbon cutting event planned for the Slater / 132nd St Crossing on June 22.
- Reminder about the upcoming paving around Evergreen Hospital this year, specifically on 128th St, just north of the Villages at Totem Lake
- The City recently completed a TBD sidewalk project on 124th Ave in Kingsgate.
- WSDOT is planning a southbound I-405 closure the upcoming weekend.
- Staff announced that Abby Evan, Public Works Administrative Assistant, this is her last meeting supporting the Commission.
