Problem

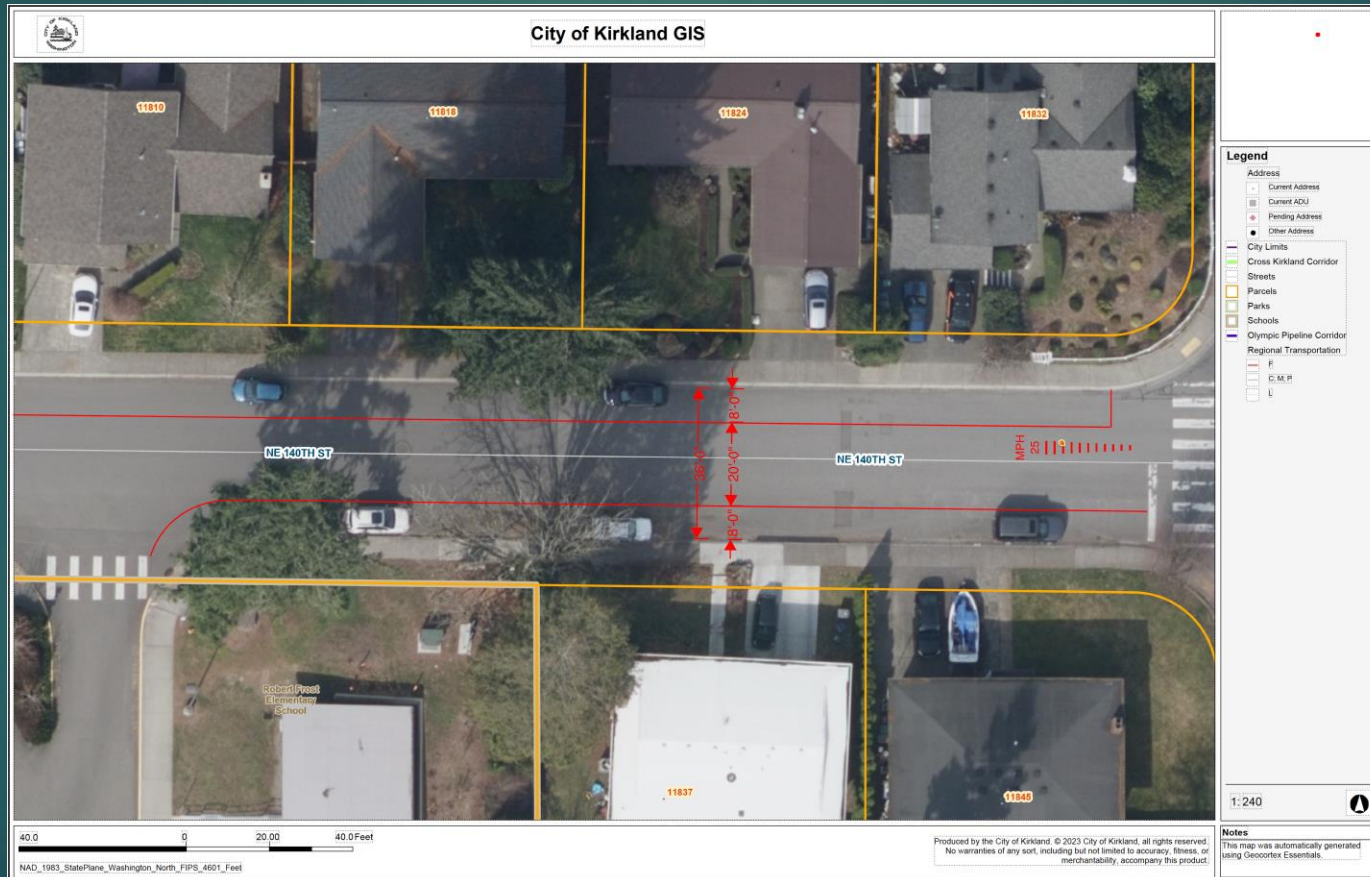
- ▶ Concerned residents have reported excessive speed on NE 140th St Robert Frost Elementary.



Solution

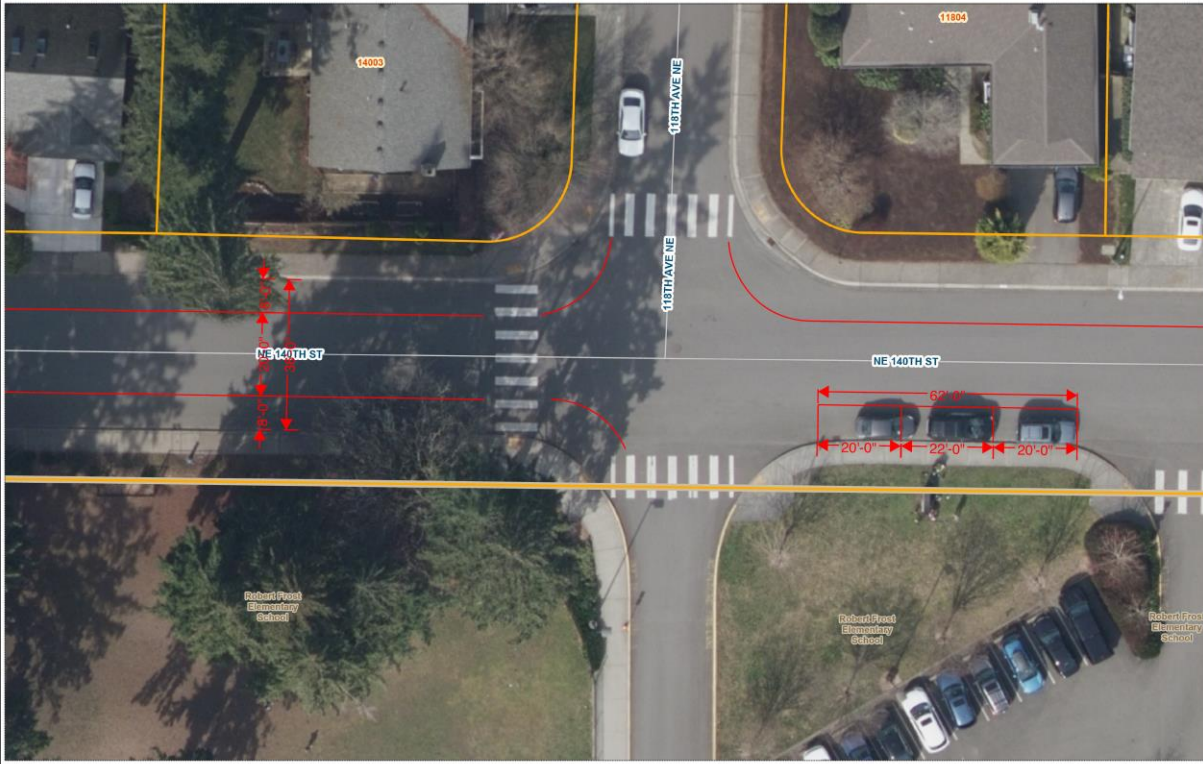
- ▶ Visually narrow the lanes through the addition of
 - ▶ Shoulder striping
 - ▶ making it 36ft curb to curb on NE 140th St.
 - ▶ Transverse markings on the street
 - ▶ Speed limit marking on the road
 - ▶ Speed limit will be determined by the traffic plan recently passed by council
 - ▶ Either 20 or 25mph.
- ▶ Cost is **Low**

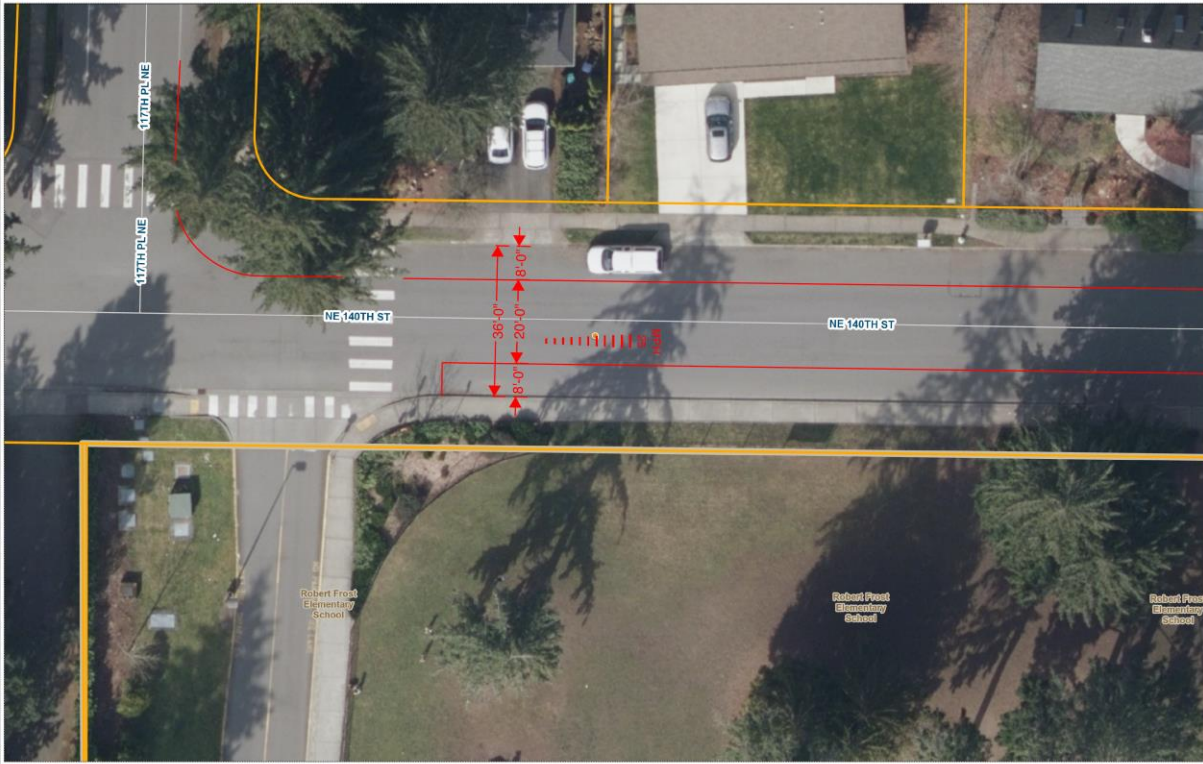
